August

- *Begin senior year

January

- *Have family income tax information figured.
- *Send seven-semester transcript to schools of choice.
- *Check out the guidance blog on the web.
- *Begin filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

February

- *If not yet completed, send in application and current transcript to college(s) of choice.
- *Send in your financial aid application to the college.
- *Beware of financial guarantees from private firms re: grants & scholarships.

March

- *Keep investigating sources of financial aid.
- *Visit campuses of schools where you have an interest.
- *Priority deadline for Kansas Tuition Grant is this month.
- *Complete college acceptance process.
- *Guidance blog!

April

- *With parents, visit campuses/colleges you are considering.
- *Sign up for early registration day at the college(s).
- *Check to see if college tour groups will be in your area.
- *Keep an eye on the guidance blogsite!

May

- ***GRADUATE!!!**
- *Notify those schools to which you have applied but will not attend.
- *Attend early registration day.
- *Take summer classes to get a 'head start'.
- *Request your counselor to send a 'final' transcript.
